## Therap Mobile Applications

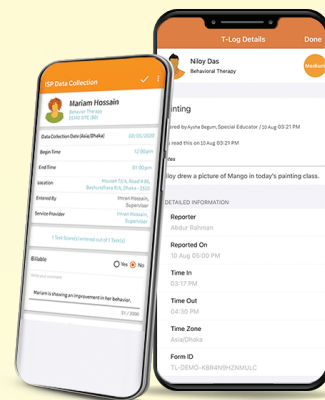
