- Head and eyes turned to the right
- Head Drop
- Jerking while conscious
- Jerky arm movements left side
- Jerky arm movements right side
- Limp body
- Loss of bladder control
- Loss of bowel control
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Picking at clothes/ taking off clothes
- Rapid blinking of eyes and/or small twitching movements
- Rigid body
- Running
- Staring spell
- Sudden dropping of objects
- Unconscious
- Unresponsive
- Violent shaking of entire body
